uesta tecnica è caratterizzata da tessere dall'effetto particolarissimo. Esse vengono recise piuttosto che segate; in tal modo la superficie resta scabra ed irregolare, ma senza perdere le caratteristiche della lucentezza del materiale.

E' proprio questa "frattura" della pietra o del marmo ad evidenziare, come in cristalli prismatici, l'intima natura del materiale, esaltata dagli effetti di rifrazione che su di esso crea la luce.

L'opera musiva creata con questa tecnica acquisisce, dunque, ulteriore pregio, aggiungendosi all'unicità del fare manuale dell'artista la singolarità dell'effetto casuale della natura, mai uguale e ripetitiva.

Ci troviamo, cioè, di fronte ad esempi che dimostrano chiaramente come il mosaico non possa semplicisticamente intendersi come pietrificazione dell'opera pittorica, in quanto la sua peculiarità non potrà mai prescindere dalla singolarità di queste tessere luccicanti, irregolari...insomma dalla natura del materiale quasi portato a nudo, svelato nella sua essenza profonda.

This technique is characterized by tesserae of very specific effect.

They are split instead of sawn; this way the surface remains irregular and rough, without losing the characteristic gloss of the material.

It is just this "fracture" of the stone or of the marble that points out, as in the prismatic crystals, the inmost nature of the material, exalted by the refraction's effect that the light creates on it.

Therefore the illusion created with this technique acquires further value because the singularity of the artist's creation adds up to nature's effect always different and never repeated.

We find ourselves namely in front of examples that clearly show how a mosaic cannot simply be intended as a petrified painting because its peculiarity will always depend on the singularity of these shining and irregular tesserae and on the nature of the material almost naked and revealed in its deepest essential quality.
